Sat. **Weiser River Trail. Easy, intermediate and advanced. Distance to be
June 10** **determined by hikers. Hike leader: Nancy Holmes.**

Weds. **Rapid River Trail. Easy, intermediate and advanced. 8
June 14** **miles RT to the second bridge with an 800 foot elevation gain. Hike leader:
Nancy Holmes. Note: This can be a very warm hike depending on weather.**

Sat. **Ponderosa State Park. Easy, intermediate and advanced. Distance to be
June 17** **determined by hikers. Hike leader: ReNae Bradfield.**

Wed. **Little Bear Basin. Easy, intermediate and advanced. Distance to be
June 21** **determined by hikers. Hike leader: Roberta Thompson.**

Sat. **Goose Creek Falls. Intermediate. 4 miles RT. 950 foot elevation gain from
June 24** **falls back to trailhead. Hike leader: Nancy Harvey.**
