

## MCCALL HIKING CLUB

**Sept, 2006 Hikes:** (All hikes will begin at 9:00 a.m. at the south end of the Rite-Aid parking lot.) All hike locations and guides are subject to change.

Sept. 2                    No hike scheduled due to Labor Day holiday weekend
- Weds.  
Sept. 6                    **Pearl and Marge Lakes.** Easy, intermediate and advanced. All hikers will go to Pearl Lake, approximately 3 miles RT with an elevation gain of approximately 250 feet. Upper intermediate and advanced will continue from Pearl Lake and bushwhack to Marge Lake approximately 2/3 of a mile away. Elevation gain is approximately 400 feet to the ridge to look down on Marge Lake. Hike leader: Bill Starowicz

Sept. 9                    **Duck Lake/20-Mile Trail Crossover.** Easy and intermediate. Approximate distance is 9 miles. We will divide the hikers into two teams leaving from both trailheads. We will meet somewhere on the trail, exchange keys and continue the hikes to the end of each trail. The trail from Duck Lake to 20-Mile trailhead starts with a climb from the trailhead to the ridge beyond Duck Lake with the remainder of the trail being a mild downgrade to the 20-Mile trailhead. The trail from the 20-Mile trailhead will have a gradual incline to the ridge above Duck Lake with a short descent to the trailhead. Those wishing an easy hike may go to either trailhead and hike to Duck Lake or to the junction on 20-mile trail leading to 20-mile Lakes. Hike leaders: To be announced.

Sept. 13                    **Crystal Lake.** Intermediate and advanced. Approximately 5 miles RT. with an elevation gain of approximately 1950 ft. via a switchback trail. Intermediate hikers may wish to go to Fall Creek Saddle with the advanced hikers going on to the lake. Hike leader: Bruce Hovey

Sept. 16                    **Twenty-Mile Lakes.** Easy, intermediate and advanced. Distance will be determined by hikers; 12 miles RT to the lakes with an elevation gain of approximately 2,200 feet. Hike leader: To be announced.

Sept. 20                    **Anderson Lake via Lick Creek Rd.** Intermediate and advanced. Approximately 8 miles RT with a significant elevation gain. Hike Leader: Tom Derieg.

Sept. 23                    **Center Ridge Trail.** Intermediate and advanced. Miles to be determined be hikers. Elevation gain unknown. This is an exploratory hike. Hike Leader: Bill Starowicz

Sept. 27                    **Six-Mile Trail.** Easy and intermediate. 6 miles one-way with an elevation gain of approximately 800 feet. This is the trail we did maintenance on last year. It takes off from Grouse Campground at the south end of Goose Lake. The van will pick us up at the other end of the trail. Hike leader: To be announced.
