- Wed June 3     Bear Basin: Easy, we will follow a new bike/hike trail in Bear Basin.  
Little elevation gain, out and back, 4 mile round trip.

- Sat June 6     Rapid River Trail: Easy, intermediate and advanced. 8 miles RT to the second bridge with an 800 foot elevation gain.

950 foot elevation gain from the falls back to trailhead ,

Elevation gain of 656 feet.
